Dear Resident Family Members/Representatives

As stated in our previous email, Gov. Hochul had announced that beginning Wednesday, January 12, 2022, all visitors must wear surgical-type masks and must show proof of a negative COVID-19 test within 24 hours prior to their visit to a nursing home. In order to meet this requirement, the City has sent Jeanne Jugan Residence self-test kits for visitor use. As such, it would help us if you would kindly follow the directives below:

1. Visitors must present the negative COVID-19 test upon entering the home. If needed, the home may provide one (1) test kit per visitor at a time.
2. Visitors may only pick-up their own kits and not another visitor's kit.
3. Self-test kits must be done at home/outside the facility within 24 hours prior to your planned visit.
4. Follow the instructions indicated in the self-test kits.
5. Please write the following on the COVID-19 test card: Name, Date and Time of Collection, Date and Time of Result
6. Once the test is completed, take a picture of the test card and present it upon entry to the nursing home. **DO NOT BRING THE ACTUAL TEST CARD INTO THE FACILITY.**
7. If your test comes out positive, please contact your healthcare provider and postpone your visit in the nursing home for at least 10 days after your positive test result and until you meet the criteria to end isolation as per CDC guidelines as our residents are considered high risk for COVID-19 infection (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/quarantine-isolation.html>).
8. Test kit should not be used for those under 2 years of age.
